## **School Day**

is still a relatively new feature of the school. Breakfast Club runs from 07:45 until 08:45 at a cost of £3 per session. This session includes breakfast of cereal or toast.

### PE

As you know, we ask that children come to school in their **PE kit** on their **PE days**. As a reminder, our expected PE kit is:

- Royal blue school sweatshirt or school hoodie (branded sweatshirts and/or hoodies can be purchased from Cloud 9 Leisure in the South Nelson Industrial Estate)
- Unbranded black/dark blue shorts or tracksuit bottoms (with no logos)
- White tee shirt or polo shirt
- Sports trainers (not wellies, boots or smart shoes)

PE days are outlined below:

Reception - Wednesday and Thursday Year One - Tuesday and Wednesday Year Two - Monday and Tuesday Year Three - Wednesday and Thursday Year Four - Monday and Friday Year Five - Monday and Friday Year Six - Monday and Tuesday

### Footwear

A reminder that **Crocs** and **open-toe sandal**s are **not appropriate** for school for health and safety reasons. If children attend school in inappropriate footwear, we will ask for you to bring an appropriate pair in.

### Year Three End of Day Arrangements

A reminder that, in a change from last year, children in **Year Three** will be required to be picked up by an adult at the end of the school day. Children in **Years Four**, **Five** and **Six** are permitted to walk home if parental permission is provided.

### **Earrings**

Along with the other schools in the **Cramlington Partnership**, we have a **no earring policy** in school for **health and safety reasons**. If your child has had their ears pierced this summer and they are not yet able to remove them for the school day, could you please place a plaster over their piercing to reduce the chance of it getting caught in something.

### Lunch

We would like to remind parents and carers that we are a **nut free school**. Please do not send anything into school which may contain nuts as we have children with severe allergies. **Hazelnut spreads** (such as **Nutella**), **cereal bars**, **nut spreads**, **nut pesto** and some '**Kinder**' products can also contain nuts. If you send in **grapes** or **tomatoes** in a packed lunch, please remember to quarter these as they present a potential choking hazard.
