Dear Parents/Carers,

At Beaconhill Community Primary School, the safety and well-being of all our pupils is our highest priority. All staff in school work diligently to provide a secure and supportive environment both within school and beyond. We would like to take this opportunity to remind you of important safeguarding considerations - particularly relating to your child's online activity.

Online Safety and WhatsApp Usage

We understand that many children use social media and messaging apps to communicate with friends and family. However, we want to remind you that WhatsApp has a recommended minimum user age of 13. While the content shared in WhatsApp groups outside of school is beyond our direct monitoring, we have a duty of care to all pupils. Recently, we have been made aware of inappropriate language and content being shared within some WhatsApp groups involving pupils.

We strongly advise you to be vigilant and mindful of your child's online activity and the groups they participate in. Open conversations about safe and respectful online behaviour are essential to help protect children from exposure to harmful content or interactions. Supporting your child in understanding how to use technology responsibly is a vital part of safeguarding.
