I am very excited that our new class set of iPads, cases and secure charging trolley have been ordered and will be arriving in the coming days. These will be used predominantly in Years Five and Six and have been purchased, in part, thanks to support with whole school fundraising drives. We aim to purchase a further 30 next year for Years Three and Four so part of our fundraising events this year will be ring fenced to fund these. Existing iPads will then be redistributed to Years One and Two. The iPads will allow children to regularly access education apps such as Times Table Rockstars and Emile. Children in Upper Key Stage Two will be using them every day so should be adept at logging on at home as well.
