Snapchat

A reminder to parents/carers of children who may be using the **Snapchat** app. Snapchat is a **social media app** designed for users aged **13** and **older**, but its use by primary-aged children raises significant **safety** and **developmental concerns**. The app's features, such as **disappearing messages**, **Snap Maps**, and **public stories**, can expose young users to **privacy risks**, **inappropriate content** and **cyberbullying**. Children at this age may lack the **maturity** to navigate these challenges responsibly, making them more vulnerable to exploitation or harmful interactions. Additionally, the **addictive nature** of the app can impact their **focus**, **mental health** and **social skills**. Parents/carers may wish to closely



monitor device use and set age-appropriate boundaries to ensure that children are safe and guided when exploring digital platforms.
