#### Year One Phonics

This week, Year One children across the country have completed their **Phonics Screening Check**. Our children have all **worked incredibly hard** to develop the **basic skills** which support **early reading** and **writing**. The progress that they have made has been **remarkable** and we're very proud of them. **Mr Shepherd** and the **Year One** team have done a fantastic job to support the children.

#### Year Four Times Tables

**Mr Gray** and our **Year Four children** have been working hard this week on their official **Multiplication Tables Check**. Much like the **Phonics Screening Check**, this is a **statutory assessment** which Year Four children across the country complete in **June** each year. A lot of effort from **staff** and the **Year Four children** has gone into the check - not least the **commitment to TTRS**. The images below **illustrate the progress** from **September** to now based on the class average time taken to answer a **multiplication question**. We are thrilled with the outcome!
