

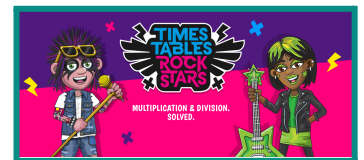
Happy Friday!

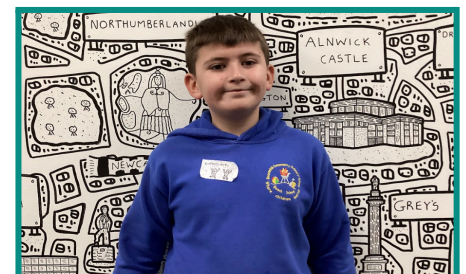
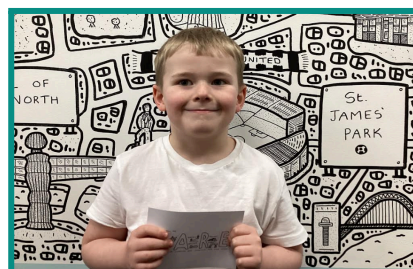
TTRS
