### School Yard

Thank you all very much for the **Halloween donations** today. As ever, your **fundraising** support makes a huge difference to what we can do in school. In **2022/23**, we used school fundraising initiatives to purchase **30 new iPads**. Last year, we used the money raised by you to contribute towards our **Early Years yard** development. Going forward, we have a large project planned for **Spring 2025** - the **resurfacing** of the **main school yard** which is now very much showing its age. This is an **expensive job** so all fundraising this year will go towards the works. This

will make play times and lunch times much more fun and safe but will also really improve our PE curriculum by having specific areas marked out e.g. a **netball court**, a **tennis court** and a **running track**.

### Lucky Tray Day


