- Super reading. S/he really enjoyed this book and could tell me about their favourite character.
- Great reading. S/he could blend some of the words independently.
- A great try. With some support, s/he could blend most of the words.
- S/he read this book really well, sounding out and blending accurately.
- Brilliant reading, s/he recognised all the tricky words.
- Lovely reading, s/he read the words without having to blend.
- Super reading, we talked about the meaning of some of the words.
- Excellent reading, s/he read with fluency and expression.
- Great reading, s/he could retell the story, in order.
- Lovely reading, s/he could ask and answers questions about the book.
- A great try, but s/he found it difficult to retell the story.
- S/he found this book difficult; s/he needed to sound out lots of words and were not sure of the tricky words.
