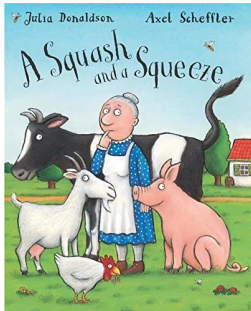


Happy Friday!
