Year Six Coding

This week, **Year Six** spent a full day learning some new skills during a **Coding** and **3D Printing workshop** with **Mr Nelson** from **Cad2Code**. It was a fantastic day which the children **thoroughly enjoyed**. In the morning, they built and coded a **robotic alarm** that sensed when an intruder got too close, displayed a **menacing face** to ward off the intruder and threw a pompom at them! Then in the afternoon, children **experienced 3D design**. They used an **online program** to design a keyring and then watched the process as the 3D keyring was printed! Keep a lookout: they will all be bringing their keyrings home in the next week or so.

Attendance

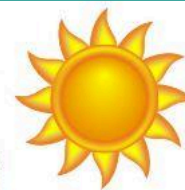
