Year Six CAD2CODE Workshop

This week, our **Year Six** pupils learned all about **Computer Aided Design** with **Mr Nelson** from **CAD2CODE**. The children explored **coding**, discovered how a **3D printer** works and designed their own keyrings using **Tinkercad**. They also tackled a **complex program** that challenged them to make a **Mars rover** capable of delivering **water** and **oxygen** to a Mars base - showcasing fantastic **problem-solving**, **creativity** and **teamwork**. We have also been able to use the **3D printer** to print their keyring designs which the children will be able to take home with them. One child summed up the day perfectly: "It was my favourite day of Year Six so far!" A huge thank you to **Mr Nelson** and **CAD2CODE** for such an **engaging** and **memorable** day of **learning**.



After School Clubs

A reminder that we will be running an after school club for **Reception** and **Year One** this half-term. Starting next Thursday (15th), we will be running a **Storytelling Yoga Club** after school every **Thursday** from **15:15 – 16:15** for the next **five weeks**. If you would like your child to take part, please **contact** the **school office** to sign up as we still have a limited number of places available. Similarly, we also have a **Multi Sport Club** starting on **Monday** for five weeks.



This club is aimed at **Year Three** and **Year Four** children. Each week, children will have the chance to try a **new** and, **potentially**, unfamiliar **sport**. The club runs from **15:15 - 16:15** and there are still a limited number of spaces available. Contact the **school office** to sign up. Please note, a **known adult** must collect children who attend all after school clubs.

Smoking and Vaping

A **reminder** that **smoking, vaping** and the use of **e-cigarettes** are strictly **prohibited** on school grounds. This



policy is in place to help ensure a **positive environment** for our **pupils, staff and visitors**. We would also **kindly ask** for your **cooperation** in being considerate around the **school perimeter**. While areas outside the school gates are not under the **school's authority**, we **respectfully request** that adults avoid smoking immediately outside the gates, particularly at the start and end of the school day when children are arriving and leaving. Your **courtesy** and **support** is greatly appreciated.

This coming **Thursday** (15th), we will have our termly '**Lucky Tray Day**'. Every child who has a **school dinner** that day will have the opportunity to win a **special prize**! On the menu for Thursday will be **chicken/veggie goujons** or a **pizza wrap** with **chips** and a **doughnut**. A choice of sandwiches (chicken, cheese or ham) will also be available. Good luck!

Uniform Reminders

A reminder that our school uniform for PE is a **royal blue jumper** or **hooded top**. I have noted an increase in children wearing either black or navy blue which is **not part of our uniform**. Many children opt to wear their normal blue school jumper for PE which is absolutely fine - a **hooded top** is helpful for the **colder months** but **not essential**. Children are also welcome to wear an **inexpensive watch** to school. **Smart watches** with the capacity to go **online**, send **messages**, take **photographs** etc are **not permitted** for **safeguarding reasons**. Expensive watches also come with a risk of being damaged which the school cannot take responsibility for. Finally, alongside all other schools in our partnership, **earrings** are **prohibited** for **health and safety** reasons. For those of you who opt to get your child's **ears pierced**, we politely ask that this is done at the start of the school summer holiday.
