PE

A further reminder that children should wear a **royal blue jumper** or hooded top for PE rather than a navy one. Our PE uniform consists of a **blue jumper**, **white tee shirt/polo shirt** and **black/dark blue joggers** or **shorts**. PE uniform must be **unbranded**.

SV5 Forms

Can you please ensure that all of the normal start of year paperwork, including SV5 permission forms and data collection sheets are returned to school by Monday please. Children will not be able to go out of school on visits without these completed forms.

Earrings

As you will already know, we have a **no earring policy** in school for **health and safety reasons**. If your child has had their ears pierced this summer and they are **not yet** able to remove them for the school day, as a **temporary measure** could you please place a plaster over their piercing. We have been advised that piercings can take **six to eight weeks** to heal so after this period, earrings **must be removed** before school. Even with tape over piercings, children cannot take an active part in PE.
