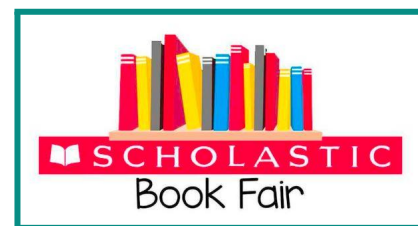
Doodle Maths
