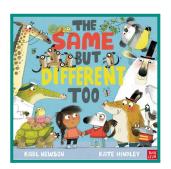

The children worked in groups to demonstrate what causes two high tides and two low tides each day. This links with our upcoming Science work on Earth and Space. Year Three also took their Science lesson to the beach this week. The children visited St Mary's Lighthouse where they spent time observing a variety of birds at the nearby nature reserve. They then used pictures to compare the skeleton of a bird with the human skeleton and they discovered some fascinating similarities and differences.
